

Applications Categories:

You can participate in one or both of the following categories:

1. Photography project: a series of photos that address a specific theme, concept or story
2. Individual photos: Open themes and submissions.

Technical Specifications

- Minimum dimension of 2400 pixels for the shorter side of the image. Maximum image size is 5 Megabyte
- Format: JPG
- Photographs should not contain watermarks, signatures or frames.
- Post-processing: basic retouching is allowed (cropping, exposure, and color corrections), advanced retouching works should be clearly labelled as digital art entries.
- Film photographs are accepted as scans with the same specifications above.
- The participant should clearly mention whether the photos have already participated in or applied for other exhibitions or contests.

Terms and conditions

By applying to the festival, you irrecoverably agree to the following rules, terms and conditions:

- You warrant that you are the sole copyright owner and creator of the photograph and that you have the right to enter your photographs in the festival activities and visibility.
- You further warrant that the photograph does not infringe upon the copyrights, trademarks, contract rights, or any other intellectual property rights of any third person or entity, or violate any person's rights of privacy or publicity.
- You acknowledge that submitted photos may be used in festival-related visibility material (online or printed), future exhibitions, and screenings locally or internationally in galleries and festivals. You retain copyrights for your photograph(s) and they will be credited whenever your work is used.
- You acknowledge that submitted photos might be shortlisted and presented in collections curated by the Festival Artistic Committee
- You agree and acknowledge that Beirut Image Festival is permitted to receive and review your registration data. You agree that personal data including, but not limited to, name, phone number, and email address may be collected, processed, stored and otherwise used for the purposes of conducting and organizing the festival.
